1. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this service request is to invite bids for assessing the fire detection system and redesigning the system to comply with the new standards. The scope also extends to the assessment and redesign of, where necessary, of the gas suppression system used for critical areas

The fire detection system should have the target protection level of people and properties as category described in SANS 10139.

2. BACKGROUND:

International best practice guidelines advise refurbishing a fire detection installation after 10 years of operation. This is particularly directed at all electronic devices, but a condition assessment must be completed for all components of the system. The existing system was installed approximately in 2018.

Investigations were conducted in numerous times previously and most of the key areas were visited and visual inspections were completed and found to be old and unserviceable.

3. REQUIRED SERVICES

Assessing the fire detection system, emergency evacuation and redesigning the system to comply with the new standards. The scope also extends to the assessment and redesign of, where necessary, of the gas suppression system used for critical areas.

The project scope further includes a condition assessment, redesign and replacement of the gas suppression systems at critical areas of the airport, i.e. substations

The bidder will assess the existing installation and provide GAAL with the new innovative design and recommendations for their consideration and approval before installation.

The bidder to try and reuse where practicable the existing structure like galvanised pipping, bases etc.

The bidder will provide GAAL with the installation/ as built and mimic drawings in both soft and hard copies.

The bidder to provide GAAL with the certificate of compliance (COC) upon completion of the project.

Compulsory site inspection to be conducted to identify, quantify and plan for the existing installation.

The bidder shall provide confirmation letter of the warrantee period.





A proposal detailing a technical approach and methodology as per the scope of work detailing how the work will be done.

The fire detection system consists of:

- 1. All addressable components such as panels, detectors (smoke, heat and optical types) manual call points, sirens and strobe lights.
- 2. All non-addressable cabling and containment systems,
- 3. All associated cabling and containment systems.
- 4. All intercommunication systems between the fibre detection systems.
- 5. System interconnections between the fibre detection system and currently installed baggage handling conveyers, HVAC, and lift system.


