RESUMPTION OF NORMAL FLIGHT OPERATIONS AT POLOKWANE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

GAAL today, welcomes the move by Air Traffic Navigation Service (ATNS) which confirms the upliftment of suspension of instrument flight procedures (IFP's) by South African Civil Aviation Authority (SACAA). The IFP's were suspended from 1st April 2025 due to outstanding submission of reviewed procedures by ATNS.

This brings to the end disruptions of delayed and cancelled flights at Polokwane International Airport. We were assured that all critical flight approach procedures were submitted to the South SACAA as part of the maintenance and have since been approved.
